

Lighthouse.Net Scholarship



- Purpose:** The purpose of this annual scholarship is to benefit a deserving student who is pursuing a four year degree at Lake Superior State University.
- Donor:** This scholarship was established by Lighthouse Computers, Inc (dba Lighthouse.Net), a wholly owned subsidiary of Cloverland Electric Cooperative.
- Background:** This scholarship has been donated by Lighthouse.Net, a local Internet Service Provider (ISP) and wholly owned subsidiary of Cloverland Electric Cooperative to benefit students who are Lighthouse Internet Subscribers and/or Cloverland Electric Cooperative Members and are pursuing a degree in Computer Sciences. It is hoped that as graduates they can then enter the local work force to improve the opportunities and technical levels in the area.
- Amount:** This award shall be \$2,500.00 to be used for tuition, books or room & board at LSSU. The donors may at any time make additional contributions.
- Eligibility:** Successful candidates:
- Must be a full-time student pursuing any area of study at LSSU with first preference given to students majoring in Computer Science.
 - Must be a current Lighthouse.Net Internet Subscriber or Cloverland Electric Cooperative Member (or both) that has been such for at least twelve (12) consecutive months prior to scholarship application. May also be the spouse or child of eligible subscriber/member.
 - Must have earned a 3.0 GPA or higher.
 - Financial need is not a requirement, but may be considered.
 - This is a non-renewable award; however, past recipients may reapply to be considered based on qualification of applications submitted and reviewed annually.
- The scholarship recipient must maintain a good academic standing and be in compliance with all policies as listed in the current Student Conduct Code.
- Application Process:** Candidates must complete the application form on-line or written copy and submit to Lighthouse.Net to confirm qualification. Upon verification, applications will be forwarded to the LSSU Financial Aid Office.
- Selection Committee:** The Financial Aid Office will follow general university scholarship policy in the selection of the scholarship recipient based on criteria developed in conjunction with the donor.
- Publicity:** Publicity is approved and encouraged in regards to this scholarship and to all future gifts.
- Changes:** If changes at the University make the purpose as designated no longer applicable, the LSSU Foundation, in cooperation with representatives of the University and Steven Mason or the current General Manager of Lighthouse Computers, Inc or authorized representative, may make revisions to meet the intent of the scholarship, the intent of the law, and/or the highest priority needs of Lake Superior State University.
